- A.** Brief Opening statement by each party unless waived by a party
- B.** For each Article, each party shall have a reasonable amount of time, including time for rebuttal by the first presenter; the Chairman, at his discretion, reserves the right to extend presentation time at the request of either party
- C.** Board of County Commissioners (Board) may ask questions at any time before, during, and after presentation of each Article by each party
- D.** Public Comment after each Article
- D.1** Rebuttal by each party unless waived by a party
- E.** Board deliberation after each Article – Board has the right to ask additional questions of either party
- F.** Board renders its decision on each Article
