

## **EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

The Indian River County (IRC) Emergency Services District Advisory Committee (ESDAC) met on Thursday, May 15, 2008 at 9:30 a.m. in Conference Room B1-501 of the County Administration Building B, 1800 27<sup>th</sup> Street, Vero Beach, Florida.
