

**RESOLUTION 05-E**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FELLSMERE, INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR APPROVAL OF THE 2005 REVISED INDIAN RIVER COUNTY UNIFIED LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on November 16, 1999, Indian River County's Unified Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) was adopted by Resolution #99-124; and

**WHEREAS**, the LMS plan requires periodic updates to comply with state and federal policies should Indian River County apply for Hazard Mitigation Grant Programs funds (HMGP); and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Mitigation Strategy has been revised and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has approved all modifications and is now ready for approval by the Board.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, BY THE City Council of the City of Fellsmere, Indian River County, Florida, as follows:

1. The Local Mitigation Strategy (a copy of which is located in the Clerk to the Board's Office as well as the Fellsmere City Clerk's Office) is hereby adopted as the official document for inclusion in the State-wide Hazard Mitigation Strategy.
2. The 2005 Revised Indian River County Unified Local Mitigation Strategy Plan has been forwarded to each municipality for their formal approval.


