**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ORCHID, ACCEPTING THE
2005 REVISED INDIAN RIVER COUNTY UNIFIED LOCAL
MITIGATION STRATEGY PLAN**

WHEREAS, on November 16, 1999, Indian River County's Unified Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) was adopted by Resolution #99-125; and

WHEREAS, the LMS plan requires periodic updates to comply with state and federal policies should Indian River County apply for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds (HMGP); and

WHEREAS, due to Hurricane Frances and Hurricane Jeanne, Indian River County is eligible for HMGP funds provided by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy has been revised and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has approved all modifications and is now ready for approval by the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF ORCHID, that:

The Local Mitigation Strategy is hereby adopted as the official document for inclusion in the State-wide Hazard Mitigation Strategy.
