- (4) Review of development projects by North Barrier Island task force members. The board of county commissioners shall appoint a group of task force members, participants, and design professionals (3 to 6 persons) to be known as the "North Barrier Island on-going review task force". Members of the on-going review task force are authorized to review and comment on development project proposals within the North Barrier Island Corridor. Task force members will be notified by planning staff regarding pre-application conferences and TRC meetings at which
