

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-036

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING INDIAN RIVER COUNTY CODE SECTION 103.03.1. "PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION" TO ADD A SCHOOL BOARD REPRESENTATIVE AS A NON-VOTING MEMBER; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in Section 103.03, Indian River County Code, the Board of County Commissioners by ordinance has established certain regulatory commissions and boards, including the Planning and Zoning Commission; and

WHEREAS, in May of 2003 Indian River County and the School Board entered into an Interlocal Agreement for public school planning, providing, in part, that Indian River County would appoint a School Board representative, designated and approved by the School Board, to serve as a non-voting member on the Planning and Zoning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said School Board member will be provided with an agenda, and invited to attend meetings and/or provide comments to the Indian River County Planning and Zoning Commission,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.

Section 103.03.1. of the Indian River County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"1. *Planning and zoning commission.* There is hereby created a planning and zoning commission to carry out the procedures, duties, and functions set forth for it in the zoning ordinances. The board shall consist of seven (7) members plus a school board representative designated and approved by the school board who shall be a non-voting member of the planning and zoning commission. The board shall be the local planning agency for the county. All members shall be residents of the county."
