

RESOLUTION NO. 89- 9

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND THE VERO BEACH-INDIAN RIVER COUNTY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, DESIGNATING THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AS THE OFFICIAL COUNTY TOURIST BUREAU.

WHEREAS, on March 10, 1987 the voters of Indian River County approved a tourist development tax and a Tourist Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, the approved plan provides for \$30,000.00 worth of tourist tax revenues to be provided to the Chamber of Commerce for tourist information services; and

WHEREAS, the Tourist Development Council is authorized by Indian River County Ordinance Section 21-253(a)(3) and by Florida Statute 125.0104(5)(a)3 to fund tourist bureaus by contract with the Chambers of Commerce in the County; and

WHEREAS, the agreement designating the Chamber of Commerce as the Official County Tourist Bureau was approved by the Tourist Development Council on August 24, 1988,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Indian River County Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body of the Tourist Development Council, hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners to execute the agreement with the Vero Beach-Indian River County Chamber of Commerce.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Scurlock and seconded by Commissioner Bowman, and, being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
