The SWMS permit authorizes the design of the sites management of rainfall runoff. The commencement of construction activities is not authorized by this permit. Commencement of construction is only authorized via the release of the site plan, receipt of a LDP or as otherwise provided for in the Indian River County Land Development Regulations.

Two (2) sets of construction plans and specifications specifically relating to the proposed stormwater/drainage improvements per Indian River County Land Development Regulations, Chapters 913, 914, 915 & 930 (no additional plans are required if this application is submitted with a Land Development Permit)
2. Certified Boundary and Topographic survey performed within the last 12 months
3. A Stormwater Management System Report as outlined in the Indian River County Land Development Regulations, Chapter 930.

Section IV. Instructions

1. Complete all information on this form and submit to the Community Development Department along with all required documents.
2. It is recommended that this application not be submitted until the project has received staff approval at the TRC level. Permit review may be placed on hold until TRC approval has been achieved.
3. All water management district and related environmental jurisdictional agency permits will be required prior to the issuance of the SWMS permit.
4. Receipt of the SWMS permit is an acknowledgement by the permittee that construction and perpetual maintenance of the project's stormwater management system will comply with applicable local, state and federal rules and regulations.
5. Permittee agrees by receipt of the SWMS permit to administer the project in a manner by which the permit conditions will be followed.
6. All other Indian River County permits, including Right-of-Way, must be applied for through separate appropriate permit applications.
