



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED SPECIAL ASSESSMENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Indian River County, Florida, will conduct a Public Hearing to consider approving a special assessment project in connection with a water main extension from 699 S. Easy Street to and including 774 S. Easy Street; 193 Chello Avenue to and including 209 Chello Avenue, 100 Becker Avenue to and including 109 Becker Avenue; 100 Charles Avenue to and including 108 Charles Avenue; 738 Holden Avenue to and including 786 Holden Avenue; and 800 Holden Court to and including 807 Holden Court, within the subdivision of Collier Creek Estates, Phases 1, 3, 4, 5 and portions of Phases 2 and 6, located within the City of Sebastian, in Indian River County, Florida.

The Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, March 14, 2017 at 9:05 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the County Commission Chambers located on the first floor of Building A of the County Administrative Complex, 1801 27th Street, Vero Beach, Florida 32960, at which time interested parties may be heard with respect to the proposed project.

Any proposed documents, including the description of each property to be assessed and the amount to be assessed to each property, may be ascertained by the public during regular business hours (8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday) at the Office of the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, located on the second floor in Building A of the County Administrative Complex, 1801 27th Street, Vero Beach, Florida.

Anyone who may wish to appeal any decision which may be made at this meeting will need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is based.
