

NOTICE - PUBLIC HEARING

The Board of County Commissioners of Indian River County, Florida, will consider the adoption of a county ordinance rezoning land within the unincorporated portions of Indian River County. A public hearing at which parties in interest and citizens shall have an opportunity to be heard, will be held on Tuesday, September 7, 2010, at 9:00 a.m. in the County Commission Chambers of the County Administration Building, Building A, located at 1801 27th Street, Vero Beach, Florida. The proposed ordinance to rezone the subject property is entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE AND THE ACCOMPANYING ZONING MAP FOR APPROXIMATELY ±2.17 ACRES LOCATED AT THE NORTHWEST QUADRANT OF S.R. 60 AND 74TH AVENUE, FROM PRO, PROFESSIONAL OFFICE DISTRICT, TO CN, NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

The rezoning application may be inspected by the public at the Community Development Department of the County Administration Building A, located at 1801 27th Street, Vero Beach, Florida, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on weekdays. The Board of County Commissioners may recommend another zoning district, other than the district requested, provided that the recommended zoning district is consistent with the county's comprehensive plan.
