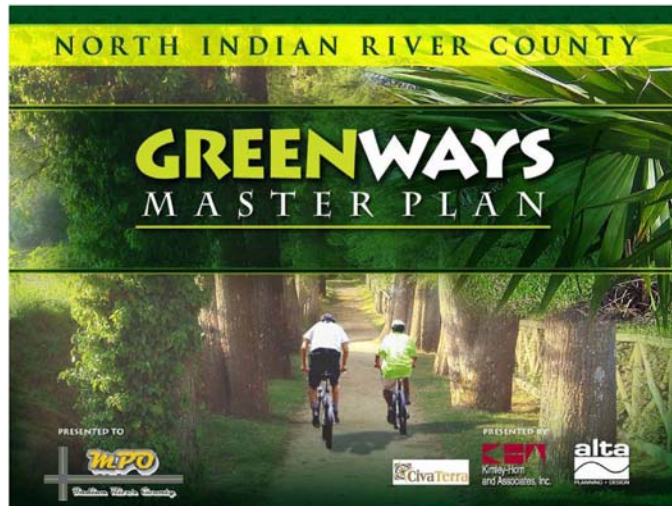

North Indian River Greenways Public Meeting Scheduled

The Indian River County Metropolitan Planning Organization (IRC MPO) is developing a Greenways plan for the Sebastian/Fellsmere/North Indian River County area. The plan will define a system of greenways that will create new hiking and biking trails, connect urban and rural areas, and improve transportation, recreation and conservation opportunities in the County. The study area for this project is the Brevard County Line in the north, the North Relief Canal (from the Atlantic Ocean to 82nd Ave) and SR 60 (from 82nd Ave to western limits of MPO Planning Area) in the south, the Atlantic Ocean in the east, and the western limits of the MPO's Planning Area Boundary in the west. The Plan will serve as a guide to the County for selecting appropriate areas for greenways, prioritizing projects, and funding, constructing, and maintaining the greenways. IRC MPO has retained the consulting team of Kimley-Horn & Associates, Alta Planning + Design, and CivaTerra for this project.
