

PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE

EFFECTIVE DATE: MONDAY, MARCH 15, 2010

IRCU CUSTOMERS OF THE FOLLOWING ADDRESSES ONLY:
2380 10TH RD SW in PRESERVES OF OSLO

DUE TO A FIRE LINE BEING HIT BY A CONTRACTOR IN YOUR AREA, WATER WILL BE OFF WHILE THE NECESSARY REPAIRS ARE BEING MADE.

THEREFORE, UPON RESTORATION OF WATER SERVICE, WE RECOMMEND THAT ALL WATER USED FOR THE FOLLOWING BE BOILED (A ROLLING BOIL OF ONE MINUTE IS SUFFICIENT):

- **DRINKING**
- **COOKING**
- **MAKING ICE**
- **BRUSHING TEETH**
- **HAND WASHING DISHES**

BOTTLED WATER MAY BE USED AS AN ALTERNATIVE.

THIS BOIL WATER NOTICE WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL A BACTERIOLOGICAL REPORT SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK. THIS PROCESS CONSISTS OF 2 DAYS OF LABORATORY TESTING AS REQUIRED BY FDEP AND CAN TAKE UP TO 72 HOURS. YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED OF RESCISSION IMMEDIATELY UPON RECEIPT OF SAID REPORT.
