



POSITION: Member of the Agriculture Advisory Committee

TIME COMMITMENT: Approximately 2 hours per meeting (approximately each quarter), serving a two-year term.

MEMBERSHIP:

The Agriculture Advisory Committee (AAC) is an advisory committee composed of seven Voting Members. Four voting members shall constitute a quorum. Members must be residents of Indian River County.

Meetings are generally scheduled as needed and held in the County Administration Building B, 1801 27th Street, Vero Beach, in Conference Room B1-501.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The primary responsibilities of the AAC are as follows:

- Advise the Board of County Commissioners regarding the promulgation, administration, and enforcement of all laws, ordinances, and rules relating to agriculture;
- Consider and study the entire field of agriculture, including agriculture economic development, to improve agriculture within Indian River County;
- Consider all matters submitted to it by the Board of County Commissioners;
- Submit proposed legislation, ordinances, and rules to the Board of County Commissioners;
- Provide rural and resource plan components and policies within the plan that affect agriculture or rural land use;
- Provide advice and recommendations on county preparation and response to proposed legislation at the state level which affects agriculture in Indian River County.
