



POSITION: Member of the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee

RESPONSIBLE TO: Indian River County

TIME COMMITMENT: Approximately (3) three hours per month, serving a (2) two year term.

MEMBERSHIP:

The Affordable Housing Advisory Committee is an advisory committee composed of (11) Voting Members and (1) non-voting liaison. Members must be residents of Indian River County. Six (6) voting members shall constitute a quorum.

Meetings are held every other month (starting with January) on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month at 9:00 a.m. at the County Administration Building B, 1800 27th Street, Vero Beach 32960 in Conference Room B1-501.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The primary responsibility of the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee is/are to:

- Provide advice to the Board of County Commissioners regarding the provision of affordable housing and workforce housing within the county;
- Assess and review new affordable housing strategies and incentives;
- Review the County's current policies and procedures as related to the provision of affordable housing;
- Review the housing element component of the County's Comprehensive Plan Evaluation and Appraisal Report;
- Review the County's Land Development Regulations as they relate to the provision of affordable and workforce housing;
- Submit a report to the Board of County Commissioners every three years, to meet state mandates, including to recommend specific actions or initiatives to encourage and facilitate affordable housing while protecting the ability of property to appreciate in value.
