### Call to Order

### Coastal Engineering Division Updates - James Gray, IRC Coastal Engineer

Mr. Gray provided an updated report on Sector 3 Post Construction Biological Monitoring - 2014, the Beach Preservation Plan (BPP) update, Fiscal

Year 2014/15 Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Beach Funding Assistance – Letter of Support; Sector 3 Beach Restoration Repair Project – Post Hurricane Sandy and Sector 3 Beach Restoration – Permit Required Reef Mitigation. A copy of the updated report is on file in the Commission Office.

### **Update from the Sebastian Inlet District Commission (the District)**

Mr. Gray reported for the District the arrival of the dredge from Hilton Head, South Carolina, arrived the weekend of March 15, 2014, which would provide for sand placement on the beach just south of Sebastian Inlet within the County's Sectors 1 and 2 beaches. He reminded the Committee the sand placement project was part of the District's inlet management plan to bypass material south of Sebastian Inlet. He pointed out the District's intention was to bypass approximately 100,000 cubic yards of sand dredged from the sand trap located within the inlet.
