



**POSITION:** Member of the Beach and Shore Preservation Advisory Committee

**TIME COMMITMENT:** Approximately 1 hour per month, serving a two-year term.

**MEMBERSHIP:**

The Beach and Shore Preservation Advisory Committee (BSPASC) is an advisory committee composed of 11 Voting Members. Members must be residents of Indian River County. Six voting members shall constitute a quorum. Members must be residents of Indian River County.

Meetings are generally scheduled for the third Monday of each month at 3:00 PM at the County Administration Building B, 1800 27<sup>th</sup> Street, Vero Beach, in Conference Room B1-501.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The primary responsibilities of the BSPAC are as follows:

- Advise the Board of County Commissioners on the study and recommended courses of action for any and all matters encompassed by Chapter 161, Florida Statute;
- Work with the County staff to coordinate and promote public and private efforts to restore and preserve Indian River County's beaches and shores;
- Work with the County staff to inform the public and governmental authorities about the environmental, economic, and social impact and importance of the beaches and shores;
- Work in unison, through the County staff, with other local, state, and federal representatives of government, public, and private interests toward the goal of preserving and restoring the beaches and shores of Indian River County;
- On an individual member basis, cooperate with outside entities to encourage and develop public awareness of the need for preservation of the beaches and shores.
