



POSITION: Member of the Community Development Block Grant
Citizen Advisory Task Force

TIME COMMITMENT: Approximately 1 hour per meeting, serving a four-year term.

MEMBERSHIP:

The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Citizen Advisory Task Force is an advisory committee composed of five Voting Members: three members shall be from low- to moderate-income households. Three voting members shall constitute a quorum.

Meetings are generally scheduled, as needed, in the County Administration Building B, 1800 27th Street, Vero Beach, in Conference Room B1-501.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The primary responsibilities of the CDBG Citizen Advisory Task Force are as follows:

- Analyze various aspects pertinent to neighborhood improvements in Indian River County;
- Provide recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners regarding CDBG application categories appropriate for the County and regarding applications to be submitted for funding;
- Provide input, recommendations, and assistance to the Indian River County staff in all aspects of the CDBG Program, including program planning, implementation, and assessment;
- Provide public awareness and outreach programs regarding the CDBG program in Indian River County;
- Reviews and provides input on the Action Plan, Consolidated Plan, Citizen Participation Plan, and Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing.
