Call to Order

Mr. Bernauer called the meeting to order at 5:35, as Chairman Hawker was not in attendance.

Approval of Minutes June 13, 2016

ON MOTION BY Ms. Falls, SECONDED BY Mr. Tanner, the members voted unanimously (6-0) to approve the minutes of June 13, 2016 as presented.

Contracts—Mr. Brad Bernauer

Mr. Bernauer reviewed the closing of the 2015-16 fiscal year. He said all agencies except Junior League's Whole Child Connection program had their final reimbursements turned in. He added Junior League had significant turnover in their Exec Dir position and eventually gave the program to the Treasure Coast Food Bank to

run. Mr. Bernauer noted that Junior League had made no contact with him or CSAC, nor did they turn in reports or return phone calls, thus their entire \$10,000 would be returned to the County's General Fund.

Mr. Bernauer discussed that the new 2016-17 contracts had been distributed to the agencies and approximately 60% had returned them signed.

There was a discussion about some of the new programs that were reaching children with different interests than what the CSAC agencies had done in the past.

Dr. Rendell discussed some of the new programs that the school district had implemented, ie: providing lunches for children during the summer. He said they had 2 buses converted to serve food to the kids.

Also there was a discussion about the new bookmobiles that were circulating through the county. There was additional general discussion about other programs.
