



POSITION: Member of the Environmental Control Hearing Board

TIME COMMITMENT: Approximately 3 hours every other month, serving a four-year term.

MEMBERSHIP:

The Environmental Control Hearing Board (ECHB) is an advisory committee composed of five Voting Members: three members shall constitute a quorum necessary to hold a meeting and take any action. Board members shall be residents and registered voters of Indian River County.

Meetings are generally scheduled approximately every 45 calendar days on Thursdays at 12:30 PM at the County Administration Building A, 1801 27th Street, Vero Beach, in the Commission Chambers.

New board members are required to complete a limited financial disclosure (Form 1). The Form 1 must also be filed annually and, upon leaving, within 60 days.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The primary responsibilities of the ECHB are as follows:

- Adopt, revise, and amend, as needed, appropriate rules necessary for the effective administration of the ECHB;
- Provide for the effective and continuing control and regulation of the environment in the County within the framework of the ECHB;
- Prior to the adoption, amendment, or repeal of any rule, give public notice of its intended action; set forth a short and plain explanation of the purpose and intended effect of the proposed rule; and summarize the proposed rule, citing Florida Statute Chapter 85-427 as specific legal authority under which its adoption is authorized;
- Perform other duties, functions, and responsibilities as may become necessary to contribute to improvement in the control of the environment in Indian River County.
