



POSITION: Member of the Transportation Disadvantaged Local Coordinating Board

TIME COMMITMENT: Approximately 1 hour quarterly, serving a 3-year term.

MEMBERSHIP:

The Transportation Disadvantaged Local Coordinating Board (TDLCB) is an advisory committee composed of 16 Voting Members. Nine voting members shall constitute a quorum. (NOTE: A quorum for the TDLCB was reduced to seven at the November, 2020, meeting because of the COVID-19 pandemic. As the pandemic subsides, it's expected that quorum requirements will be changed back to nine.)

Meetings are generally scheduled quarterly on the fourth Thursday of the month at 10:00 AM at the County Administration Building B, 1800 27th Street, Vero Beach, in Conference Room B1-501.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The primary responsibilities of the TDLCB are as follows:

- Identify local service needs and to provide information, advice, and direction to the Community Transportation Coordinator (CTC) on the services to be provided to the transportation-disadvantage population;
- Review, make recommendations, and approve the memorandum of agreement including the Transportation Disadvantage Service Plan;
- Provide the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) or Designated Official Planning Agency (DOPA) with a general system performance evaluation, with specific consideration of insurance, safety requirements/standards, and quantitative performance results;
- In cooperation with the CTC, review and provide recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners and the MPO or DOPA on all applications for local government, state, and federal funds relating to transportation;
- Review strategies and seek innovative ways to improve cost effectiveness, efficiency, safety, working hours and types of service within the county.
