INDIAN RIVER COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER 2021-001


WHEREAS, on May 28, 2021, I, in my official capacity as County Administrator, and acting pursuant to section 101.10(1) of the Code of Indian River, and Resolution 2020-104 of the Board of County Commissioners, declared that a local state of emergency exists in all of Indian River County, Florida, by reason of wildfires; and

WHEREAS, by reason of such declarations of a state of emergency, and pursuant to the authority granted in me in my capacity as County Administrator, I am authorized to enter emergency orders necessary to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Indian River County, including, without limitation, those orders authorized in chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and chapter 101 of the Code of Indian River County, and other applicable law;

NOW, THEREFORE, this Emergency Order is issued declaring a mandatory burn ban for all areas of Indian River County west of Interstate-95 prohibiting all outdoor burning that has not been specifically permitted by the Florida Forestry Service. Bonfires, campfires, and the burning of vegetative (yard) debris west of Interstate-95 is not allowed at this time.

THIS EMERGENCY ORDER shall be in effect throughout Indian River County from 8 a.m. on May 29, 2021 until 8 a.m. on June 5, 2021, or until further order.
