Please join Indian River County staff and their design engineers in this public meeting to discuss the Lost Tree Islands Conservation Area (LTICA) habitat restoration and enhancement project. Spoil islands are a common sight in the Indian River Lagoon. Learn what makes the Lost Tree Island enhancement project a unique opportunity to provide a sanctuary for wildlife, improve water quality, and provide passive recreation for the public within this 500+ acre complex of islands.

During this public meeting, you will be provided the opportunity to review the design plans for each island and become informed on the process involved in enhancing the habitat within the three large "outer" islands that are part of the LTICA.

Located north of the City of Vero Beach and south of the Town of Indian River Shores, this project will be the largest Lagoon restoration project undertaken by the County to date. Throughout the design process, the County has collaborated with numerous State and Federal agencies, and is fortunate to have partnered with the Indian River Lagoon Council on the development of these project plans. Public input and discussion is being sought as this project moves to the final design stage.
